# 7. District Policy, Planning, Activities, Projects, & Grants

- a. District Work Plan Check In on Progress Shaw reported the black text in the document is the update. Janski reported that the report is getting longer, but good information to help the Board know what is happening at the office; the report is more goal orientated rather than task orientated and he a likes the direction it is going.
- b. Personnel Committee Report LaSalle reported the committee focused on civic governance and active citizenship goals of the District. The committee identified two gaps: autonomy in writing staff reports and staff comfort with civic governance and active citizenship. The committee is looking for these two gaps to be closed by the December check in.
- c. Comprehensive Watershed Planning (1W1P)
  - i. Rum River Watershed based implementation organizational structure Janski reported he is looking for a recommendation from the Board to bring to the August Policy meeting. The two options are collaboration joint powers agreement or entity joint powers agreement.

- f. Motion by LaSalle to approve District Administrator to sign Private Forest Management coordination for the Rum 1W1P/Landscape Stewardship Plan and MNDNR contract; Hoefert second. Affirmative by Roll Call: Stoeckel, Hoefert, LaSalle. Opposed: none. The motion carried.
- g. Motion by Hoefert to approve District Administrator to sign BWSR RIM contract; LaSalle second. Affirmative by Roll Call: Stoeckel, Hoefert, LaSalle. Opposed: none. The motion carried.
- h. Eggen Wetland Restoration Project Shaw reported that Nathan Sanoski, Farm Bill Technician for Mille Lacs and Benton County, has a project to restore a wetland in Mille Lacs County. Benton SWCD will be granted the funds from the Nature Conservancy to complete the project.

- c. 2020 budget comparison to date (as of June 30, 2020) Kuchenbaker reviewed the budget. Hoefert asked about the conservationist of the year. Kuchenbaker will follow up with the technicians.
- d. Finance Committee Report Hoefert reported possible 14% decrease in State funding. The committee decided to ask Mille Lacs County for the same allocation as last year. Shaw reported she is in discussions with Mille Lacs County regarding CARES Act relief funds and possible partnership to purchase laptops. Motion by Hoefert to authorize District Administrator to purchase a third laptop if the two budgeted laptops are reimbursed from the CARES Act relief fund via Mille Lacs County; LaSalle second. Affirmative by Roll Call: Stoeckel, Hoefert, LaSalle. Opposed: none. The motion carried.
