Minor RRCWMP Amendment

Isanti SWCD proposes a minor amendment to the RRCWMP.

BWSR Criteria for a minor amendment is describes here:

<u>Minor Amendment</u>. If the proposed amendment meets the criteria below, a minor amendment procedure can be used.

1. Minor Amendment Criteria. An amendment can proceed as a minor amendment if the BWSR board conservationist and the regional manager agree that the following criteria are met:

(i) The amendment does not create a new funding mechanism (e.g., water management district) or a new program that would have significant implications for local funding or taxing; and

(ii) The amendment does not change overall plan priorities or goals

Anticipated timeframe

- September 13-November 1 IPC submit amendments to Tiffany
- November IPC: IPC reviews amendments and recommends final list to RRWP
- January 25: RRWP board approve minor amendment(s)
- January 26 to begin: BWSR 30-day comment period
- March 28 RRWP board meeting: public hearing
- Finalize
