



**Resolution to Adopt and Implement
the Mississippi River St. Cloud
Comprehensive Watershed Management Plan**

WHEREAS, Wright Soil and Water Conservation District (SWCD) has been notified by the Minnesota Board of Water and Soil Resources that the Mississippi River St. Cloud Comprehensive Watershed Management Plan has been approved according to Minnesota Statutes §103B.101, Subdivision 14 and Board Resolution #25-05:

NOW; BE IT RESOLVED: Wright SWCD hereby adopts and will begin implementation of the approved Comprehensive Watershed Management Plan for the area of the county identified within the Plan. The Comprehensive Watershed Management Plan replaces the Wright County Local Water Plan for SWCD purposes for the area of the county identified within the Plan.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: Wright SWCD terminates its rights and obligations under the Mississippi River St. Cloud Watershed Memorandum of Agreement with the last date of the signature being September 28, 2022 for developing the Comprehensive Watershed Management Plan and the establishment of an organizational structure for the implementation of the Plan.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: Wright SWCD shall enter into the joint powers agreement for the Implementation of the Mississippi River St. Cloud Comprehensive Watershed Management Plan with such entity being known as the “Mississippi River St. Cloud Watershed Entity” and authorizes its chair to execute such document.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that, pursuant to the terms of said joint powers agreement, Wright SWCD Board of Supervisors shall appoint a representative annually, to serve as a representative of Wright SWCD on the Mississippi River St. Cloud JPE Board.


